Marriage Chamber

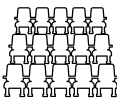
The Marriage Chamber is located on the first floor of the monumental wing of The Grand and wasdesigned by artist Chris Lebeau, who completed this room in 1925. The Marriage Chamber is still used today as a location for weddings and private dinners. The wall paintings, with unique colour combinations, in this room symbolize the story of life. From the balcony of the Marriage Chamber you can overlook the beautiful inner garden of The Grand. The Marriage chamber provides an elegant setting with a harmonious ode to marriage and love.






The Council Chamber was built in 1924 as the seat of Amsterdam's city council and is now listed as a historical monument. Designed in the expressive Amsterdam School style, the chamber is known for its collection of wooden sculptures by various renowned artists from that period, and chandeliers by versatile Dutch designer Frits Lensvelt. In this iconic setting, our former Queen, Princess Beatrix, was married in 1966.

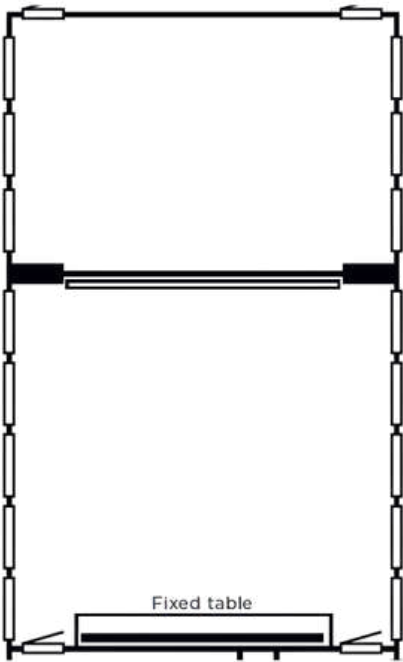


St. Cecilia Chamber

The St. Cecilia Chamber is one of the historical meeting rooms located on the first floor and overlooks the courtyard of The Grand. Previously used as the coffee room of the former city hall of Amsterdam, this square-shaped room is situated right next to the Council Chamber. Designed in the expressive Amsterdam School style, it features a remarkably high ceiling, historical wood-carved panels by Hildo Krop, and chandeliers by versatile Dutch designer Frits Lensvelt

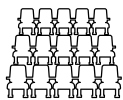
Aldermans Chamber

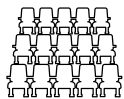
Burgomaster Chamber

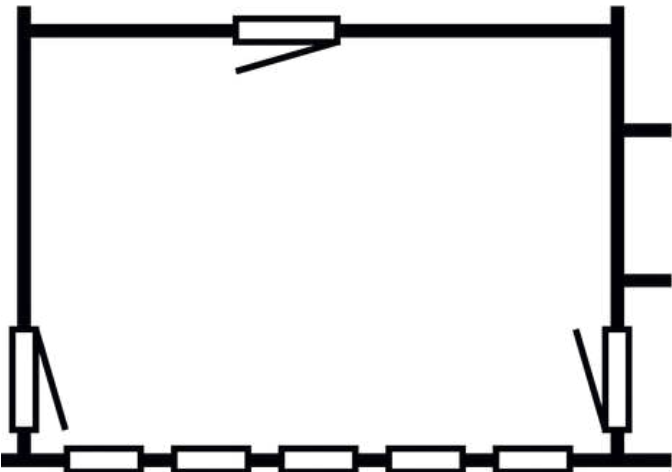

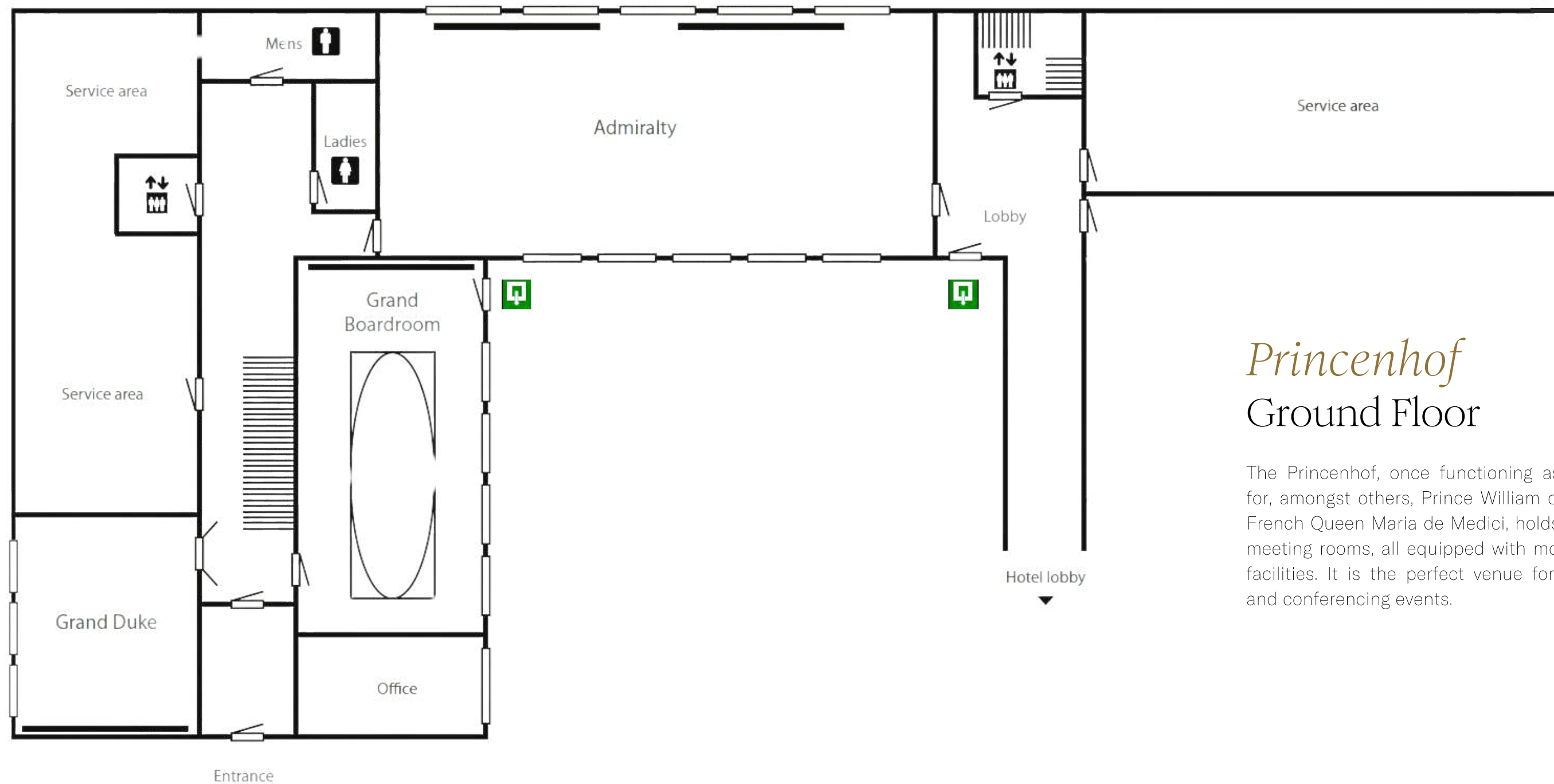

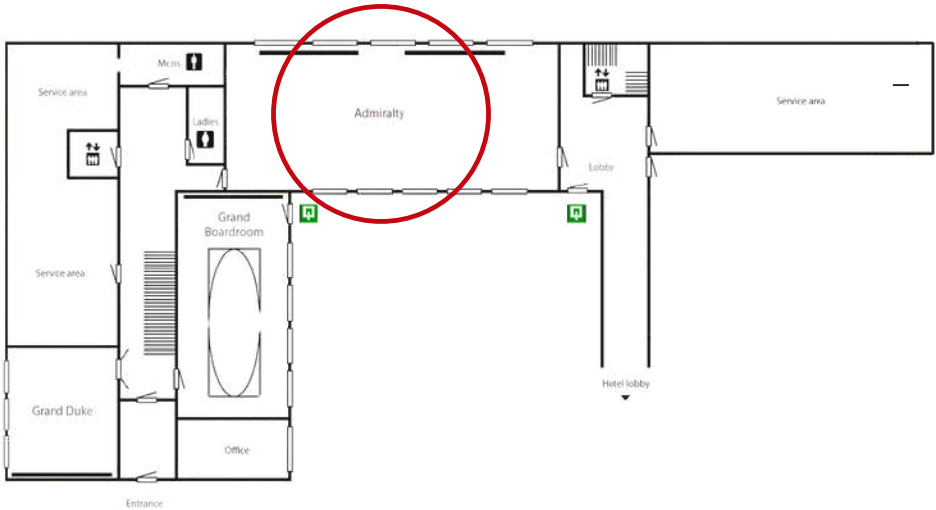

Admiralty

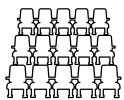

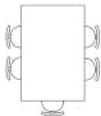
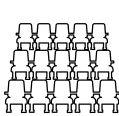
Prince
